


Transporation Data

- Roads Data:
 - Developed world: Good data but copyright protected and costly
 - Developing world: Generally poor data
 - Inconsistencies across neighboring countries and VMAP tiles
 - CIESIN has produced a white paper that describes several strategies for filling gaps (interest expressed by Netherlands Environmental Assessment Agency (MNP), World Bank and others)
- Airports: Best source is proprietary but may be useable by GRIP




Estimated percentage of roads represented by VMAP0






VMAP1 tiles publicly available








Water Quantity



GRDC/UNH Runoff Grid






WCMC Forest Cover Map


Percent Forest Cover Map
