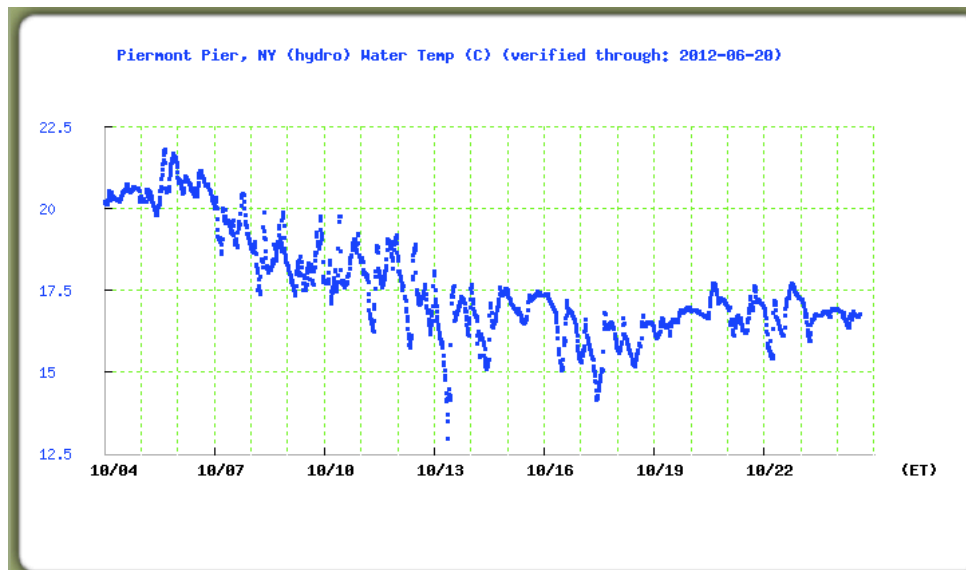
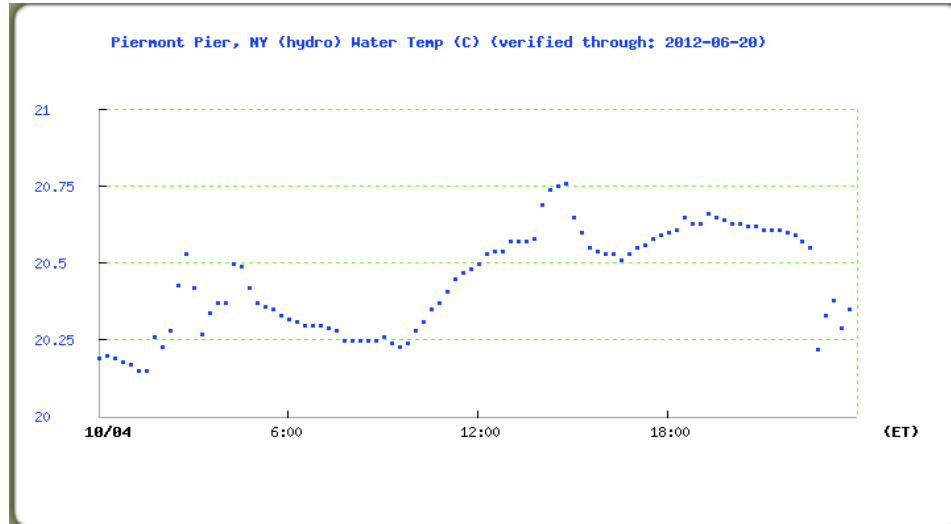

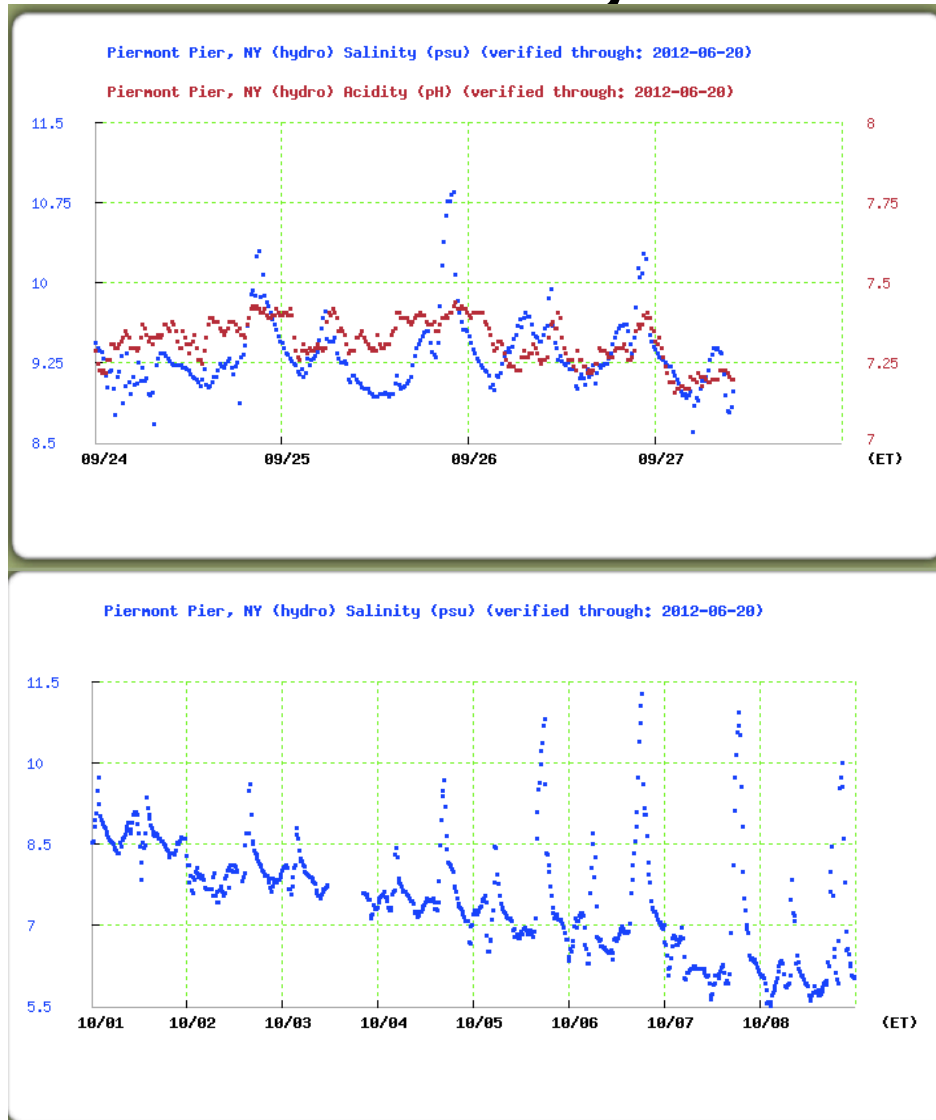


Cooling trend after 10/4/12





# Salinity

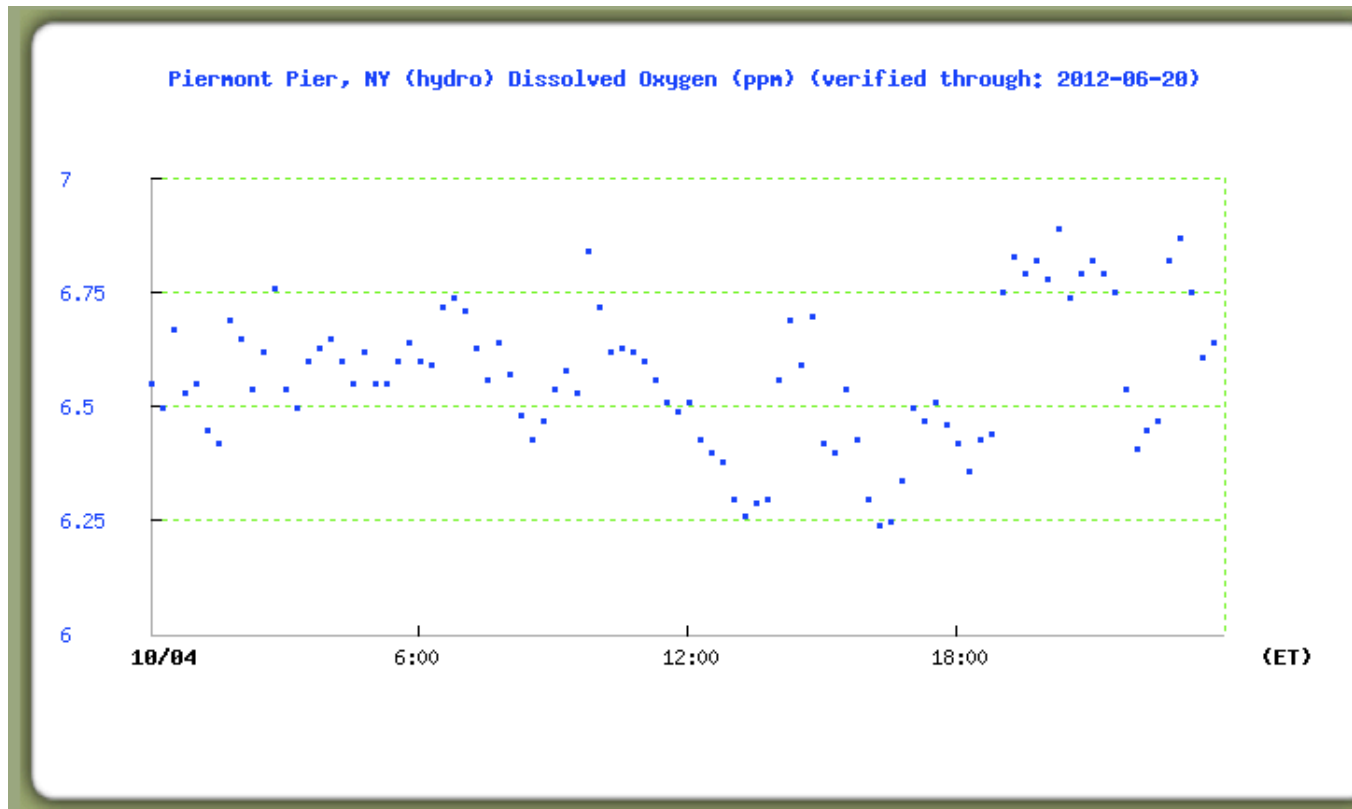


Dropping going into Day in the Life and continues to fall after.

- Throughout the river Vallisneria amounts were low after Hurricane Irene tore through the system in August 2011.





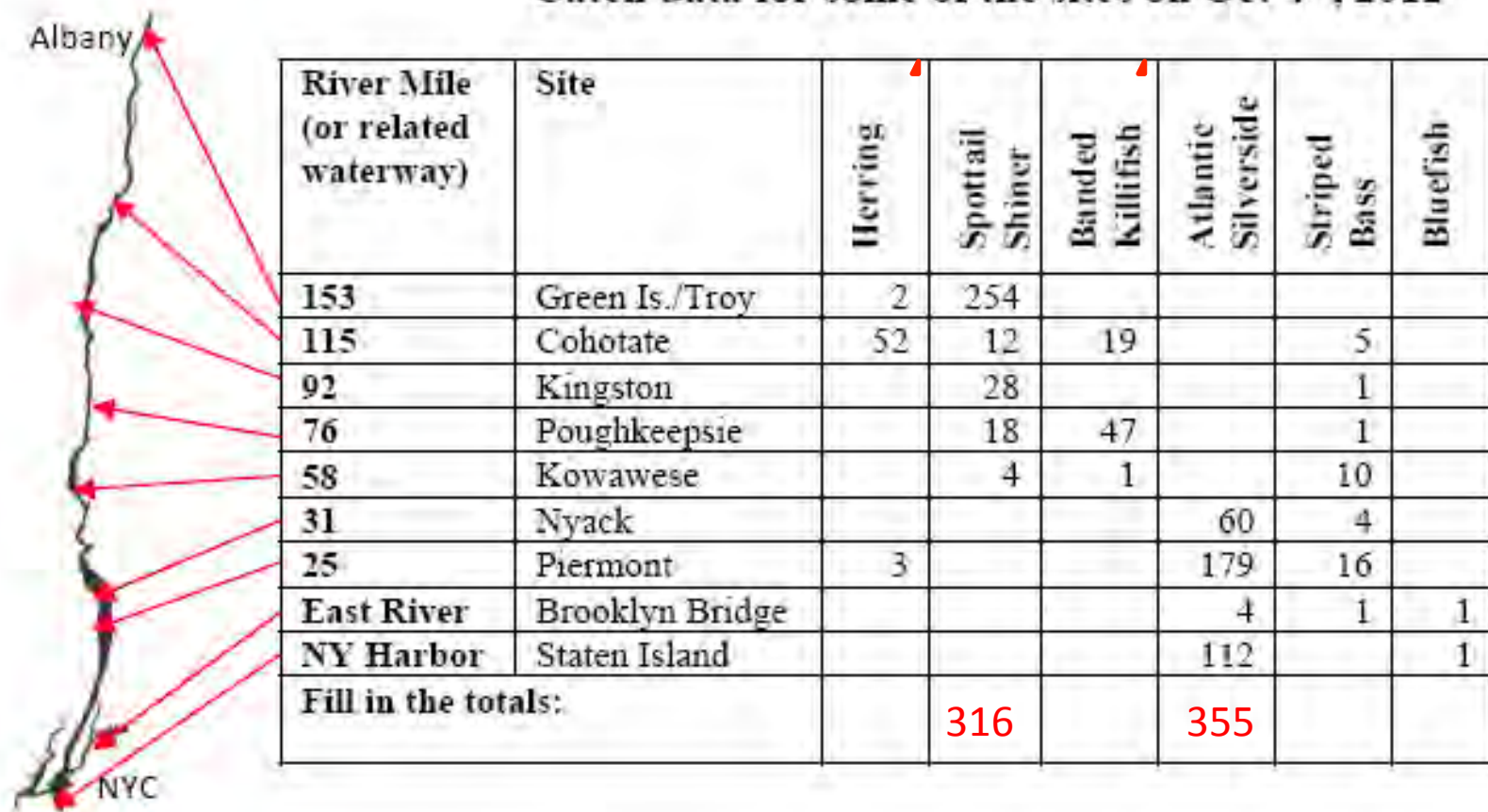

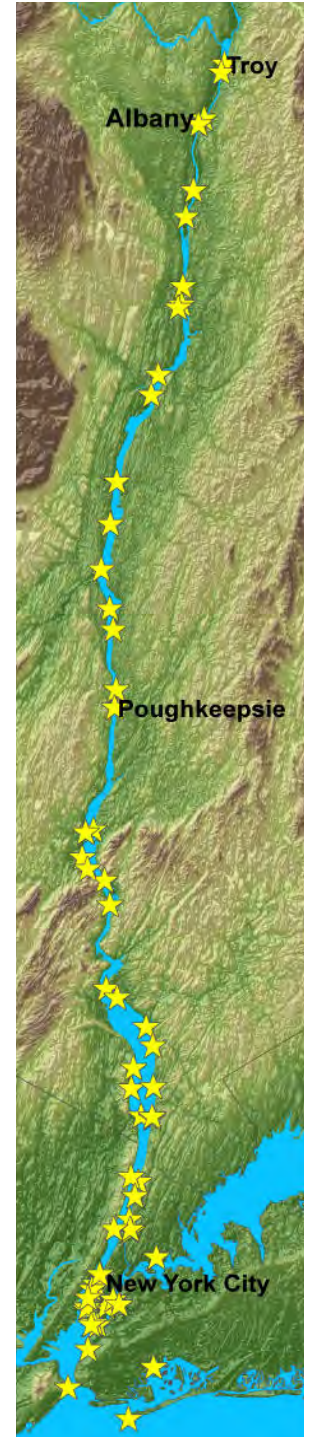

- Hudson NY RM 118: 0.087 ppt; banded killifish & sunfish



- Verplanck RM 41: 2.4 ppt; Atlantic silversides & striped bass



- Bay Ridge Flats RM -1: 23 ppt; seahorse & windowpane flounder
