

Location: Pier 40 Hudson River (also called North River)

Area: Off southern side of Pier 40 about 600-800 feet down the pier from shore. Large urban pier with many sports facilities: athletic fields, kayaking and boathouse, seasonal moorings available, parking, fishing on the pier, benches & picnic tables for the public **Surrounding Land Use:** 100% Urban/residential;

Sampling Site: Bulkhead, Banks altered; concrete & wood pilings, large pier extends into river/cement bulkhead south $\sim 100 \text{ m}$

Shoreline: Rocky

River Bottom: Soft sediment habitat, muddy

Plants: no

NOTE: This highly urban site is just west of the busy Westside Highway – it is the largest pier in Hudson River Park (with a 14 acre footprint); Pier 40 is used for recreation; school groups use the athletic fields; there are 3 public boathouses; there are many people by on the river's edge: jogging, bike riding, walking.
