



GREEN FEATURES

Pervious pavers to allow stormwater to be absorbed through the surface and put back into the ground. Inexpensive and prevents runoff – instead get run-in.

Treating Rainwater: We will include rain gardens to retain and treat stormwater. Rain barrels will be added and native plantings to reduce run-off and improve aesthetics.

Composting: Compost in the rain garden – biodegradable waste.



BLUE COMMUNITY FEATURES
