Methane in the Climate System: Monitoring Emissions from Space

Methane is an important greenhouse gas but its sources are very poorly understood. Satellite observations of atmospheric methane provide unique information for quantifying sources of methane and their trends. Here I will present recent work using these observations for better understanding methane on a global scale and down to the scale of individual point sources.
